

## Inner-City Home Sudbury/Sudbury 5 In game 50/50 Raffle Rules of Play

### Rules of Play for 50/50 Raffle:

1. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older to enter the *Inner-City Home Sudbury 5 in person electronic 50/50* Raffle. Ticket purchaser must be in the province of Ontario at the time of ticket purchase.
2. The raffle will take place during Sudbury 5 Home games 2023 schedule – The raffle to begin 1 hour prior to start of game. Jan 7 Sat – 7pm, Jan 8 Sun – 2pm, Jan 14 Sat – 7pm, Feb 12 Sun – 3pm, Feb 20 Mon – 2:30pm, Feb 25 Sat – 7pm, Mar 2 Mon – 7pm, Mar 9 Thurs – 7pm, Mar 11 Sat – 7pm, Mar 19 Sun – 2pm, April 1 Sat – 7pm, April 2 Sun – 2pm, April 8 Sat – 7pm April 15, Sat – 7pm, April 16, Sun – 2pm, April 22 Sat – 7pm, April 23 Sun – 2pm, May 2 Tues – 7pm. Raffle (winning number drawn) to take place early within 5 minutes of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of play. Location: Sudbury Community Arena, 250 Elgin St. Sudbury ON. P3E 3N6
3. Tickets are available for purchase at the following prices: 3 for \$5.00 – 10 for \$10.00 – 60 for \$20.00.
4. Tickets will be available at Sudbury 5 Home games 2023 Schedule – location 240 Elm St. Sudbury, ON.
5. To purchase an online ticket in the Raffle, you must supply us with certain personal information (such as name, home address details, date of birth, payment card details and e-mail address). Certain information (NTD: name, home address details, date of birth, and e-mail address) may be shared with AscendFS Canada Ltd. (“Ascend”) in order to process your request to purchase a raffle ticket. By purchasing a ticket, you consent to us sharing this information with Ascend. 6. Tickets will be sold using the electronic raffle system supplied by Ascend Fundraising Solutions.
7. For those raffle tickets purchased in-person, patrons will be given by the sellers, a receipt with their 50/50 registered numbers from a Random Selection System. No specific numbers can be given as numbers are generated randomly. All tickets purchased online will be delivered via email only. It is the responsibility of the ticket purchaser to ensure that they receive their tickets, however, purchasers do not need their tickets in hand to be included in the draw. 8. The winning ticket number will be selected by Random Number Generator (RNG), from all raffle ticket numbers sold during the designated raffle period.
9. The amount of the 50/50 will be posted on inhouse monitors score clock, public announcer updates during the games.

10. The winning number will be announced via the in-house public broadcaster, score clock and both the innercityhome.com and thefive.ca web sites, winner to be emailed or call accordingly at the conclusion of the draw.
11. If the patron with the winning number on their ticket is at the event where the number has been drawn, they may then come to the Sudbury 5 administration office 240 Elm St. Sudbury, ON P3E 3N6 or Inner-City Home Sudbury 251 Elm St. Sudbury, ON P3C 1V5.
12. The winner will be paid by cheque for the amount posted at the event and online via the online sales purchase portal for which they bought their ticket. Winners must have the original winning ticket and no copies.

14. Winners will be required to provide their full name, address and phone number upon claiming their prize. Once the certified winner is verified, they will be given a cheque in the amount of the declared prize which is, at minimum, 50% of the total sales for that event. If the winner cannot provide photo ID, then the winning proceeds will be held until such identification can be provided.
15. In the event that no winner comes forward, prizes will be secured for a period of six (6) months following the draw. Unclaimed prizes will be reported to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario and a charitable donation will be made to another organization, under the approval of the AGCO.
